

#### **Scheduled Maintenance**

All American Pest Control- sprays the outside of all buildings once a quarter. The next scheduled pest control application will be the week of October 17th. #### <u>RV Parking</u>

There has been frequent vandalism to items stored in the RV Parking Lot. In order to curtail this activity, the following has been done:

- Security camera has been installed to monitor the area.
- Fence has been installed along the top of the wall around the lot where kids have been observed crossing over onto the property.

#### <u>Pets</u>

We continue to observe dogs roaming Willow Run without leashes and/or owners. Please remember that our community rules state the following: "The owner of any dog must keep such dog on a leash when outside of the Unit or keep it confined within the Unit... Owners shall be responsible for removal of wastes of their animals from the Common Areas and Limited Common Areas."

#### Landscaping

There has been a lot of action this summer replacing sprinkler heads, bodies, and valves, etc. The sprinkler system under some of the large trees is being redesigned and reinstalled. Once this is completed, we will be planting decorative, drought-resistant bushes and plants.

#### <u>Pool</u>

The pools have been a major challenge this summer. We have tried very hard to keep everyone updated when the pools have been out of service. Shortage of parts and third-party schedules have caused some unwanted delays in completing repairs. A major electrical incident where the master breaker failed caused a total failure of the hot tub chlorine pump and burned up the capacitors to both the indoor pool and hot tub heater.
